Dear Charles H Mount Jr,

Thank you for submitting your 406 MHz emergency beacon registration. In the event that your beacon is activated the information you provided will be appended to the distress message transmitted to a Rescue Coordination Center. This information is critical for Search and Rescue (SAR) forces locating you, your vessel, or your aircraft in a timely manner and could possibly save your life.

The registration information you have provided has been entered into our database and a printout of this information is enclosed. You may review and update your registration at: www.beaconregistration.noaa.gov. You may also make changes by hand on the enclosed printout and return it to us at the address shown below or by fax at: 301-817-4565.

A proof-of-registration decal is also enclosed. This decal is proof that your beacon is registered with NOAA. You should affix the decal to the beacon in the space provided, or in such a way that it is visible when the beacon is properly mounted. Please be sure the area is clean and dry when affixing the decal. It will take 48 hours for the decal adhesive to properly bond. A laminate is provided to protect the decal from exposure to the weather. Please place this laminate over your decal.

Registration of 406 MHz emergency beacons is mandatory and only valid for two years. You are required to re-register your beacon with NOAA in two years. We will email or fax you a request for confirmation approximately two months prior to the expiration of your beacon registration.

Finally, we ask that you carefully read your owner's manual for instructions on installation and self-testing, as well as on proper removal and stowage of your beacon. These are important factors in ensuring the beacon works correctly when needed and reducing false alerts which needlessly tie up SAR forces and waste valuable resources.
